While a broken solar panel may seem like a lost cause, it's important to understand that it could still have some functionality left, depending on the extent of the damage.

A 2023 NREL study found cracked panels lose 15-30% efficiency while still producing dangerous voltage levels. It's like having a broken garden hose that occasionally sprays boiling water.

Typical home solar installations shut down during a blackout, but you can keep the lights on in 1 of 3 ways: a generator, battery, or a special solar inverter.
