How many radio stations are there in Tanzania?

These are regulated by the Tanzania Communications Regulatory Authority. With 183 radio stations and 45 percent of the population relying on radio as their primary source for daily news, this media platform is the most predominant and widely embraced in Tanzania. There are approximately 229 newspapers, 22 blogs and online news sites in Tanzania.
