Why is Norway a key energy partner for Europe?

This surge in exports has solidified Norway's position as a crucial energy partner for Europe, supplying about 25% of the EU's gas demand. The country's increased gas production, up by 8% in 2022 compared to the previous year, has been vital in helping Europe reduce its dependence on Russian gas.

Iceland ranks as the most energy-resilient country, with nearly 90% clean energy use and rapid hydroelectric restart capability. Norway takes second place, thanks to its exceptional hydro capacity.

Norway decided to stay out of OPEC, keep its own energy prices in line with world markets, and spend the revenue--known as the "currency gift"--in the Petroleum Fund of Norway.
