Falls from Heights: Installing solar panels on high-rise buildings or elevated structures exposes workers to significant fall risks. Without proper fall arrest systems, the danger of slipping, ...

In Case of Emergency Involving Solar Panels: Call 911 and notify first responders that PVs are involved. Turn off AC side of solar panels.

As more solar panels are installed on the surface of a roof, the walking area which may once have been available, may no longer be available to workers. This may force workers to squeeze by or walk very ...
